It has been a lovely week in school. The sun is shining and the children are working hard.

## Healthy Eating...IMPORTANT CHANGES

As I'm sure you are aware, we are committed to being a "Healthy School." As a result, I have listened to the children from our ECO Committee and have come to the decision that children will only be allowed to bring in healthy snacks for break time and water in a drinks bottle, (no squash or sugary drinks). Also, if your child has "packed lunch" they will be able to have crisps but please no chocolate in their lunch boxes. From this Monday 19<sup>th</sup> June, we will be bringing back our daily fruit tuck shop. The children will be able to choose from bananas, apples, kiwis, or tangerines. We will charge a small fee of 30p per item of fruit to help to cover costs.

Furthermore, if any children continue to bring in crisps, chocolate, or sweets **for break time**, these will be confiscated and returned at the end of the day. This will apply from this Monday 19<sup>th</sup> June. This also fits in with our sustainability growing projects and teaching the children about how to stay healthy, plus we will be able to put all the peelings and leftovers into our compost bins for our school garden. Of course, there will still be some occasions in school where treats are allowed such as ice creams and ice lollies and birthday cake etc..., as this fits in with our teaching of "treats for special occasions." As Headteacher, I feel a huge responsibility to help the children be as healthy as they can be whilst at All Saints. If you would like to talk about these changes, then please come and speak to me.
