No Smoking Policy

The purpose of this document is to set out the School's policy and offer guidelines on the issue of Smoking.

All Saints Catholic Primary School recognises that everyone has a basic human right to breathe unpolluted air.

In support of this the School operates a "No Smoking Policy" and enforces the Welsh Assembly Government's policy in not allowing smoking in public buildings.

This means that all staff, governors and visitors to the school will not be permitted to smoke in the School building or grounds.

Staff and Governors at the School will not seek to promote or glamorise smoking.

Members of staff who wish to smoke will not be permitted to smoke during their working time.

Members of staff who are smokers should discuss the situation with the Headteacher.

Children will be offered appropriate advice and guidance with the School's arrangements for teaching topics covered by Health Education.

Children who are known to smoke will be offered similar advice and guidance.

Children who bring cigarettes etc. to School will have these confiscated. The Headteacher will be informed of the situation. The Headteacher will invite the parents of the children into School to discuss the situation.
