## **A reminder that school starts at 8:50am and finishes at 3:15pm**

Please can I remind everyone that your child must be in school by **8:50am** every morning. If they are attending breakfast club then they must be in school no earlier than **8:20am** and no later than **8:40am**. The Local Authority are monitoring lateness of children, which in some cases can be treated the same as an unauthorised absence and could lead to a fine. Also, if your child is late, they are missing out on the start of lessons which over time, will have a negative effect on their education so please can I ask that your child is in school, on time every day.

Also, please note that school finishes at **3:15pm**. All after school clubs finish at **4:00pm**. Please can you ensure that you are on time to collect your children from school as it is upsetting for the children if you are late collecting them.

## **Safeguarding**

As I mention on many of my newsletters, keeping the children safe in school is my first priority. The school gates will now be locked at 9am in the morning and opened at 3pm. If you need access to the school during the day, please use the main gate opposite the main entrance and wait in the secure area in reception.
